1. Final car running at the end of each heat will be the winner.
2. Top 3 cars in each heat will advance to the feature event.
3. Consolation heat will be determined upon number of entries.
4. Best of show trophy to be awarded both nights.
5. Most aggressive driver trophy to be awarded both nights. In memory of 57 & 69

Full Size Car And Compact Car: Monday And Saturday:

1. All drivers must supply their own car, any front engine, hard top car, or station wagon is allowed with the exception of jeeps, convertibles, limousines ect. No wagon roof tops folded down allowed. Pacers and Imperials are allowed.
2. Cars must retain factory cooling system.
3. Battery must be relocated to the passengers side floor and securely anchored and covered with a suitable shield.
4. Gas tank must be removed from its original location. A boat tank or metal equivalent may be used, and must be secured and covered with a shield. If car has electric fuel pump it must have a kill switch located in the drivers compartment.
5. Transmission cooler is permitted, and must be secured and covered with a shield.
6. Hood latches and springs must be removed but hood hinges must remain.
7. Station wagon rear interior decking must be completely removed.
8. A maximum of 9.50LT tire size is permitted. No studded tires. No split rims. Loaded tires are permitted.
9. Drivers seat back must be supported by pipe or wire from seat back to roof.
10. Hoods cannot be welded or bolted they may be wired only. Maximum of 6 locations. Wiring to the bumper is allowed.
11. The bottom of each bumper cannot be more than 24 inches off the ground, and the bottom of each bumper must be at least 12 inches from the ground.
12. Welding bumpers to the frame is allowed. Welding rear bumper to the truck lid or tailgate is allowed. Welding not to exceed 3 inches wide x 12 inch long plate.
13. Leaf springs may be used on the rear of coil spring cars.
14. A maximum of 9 leaf springs, 4 clamps per side. Springs not to exceed 3/8 thick, and 2-3/4 wide. No taping springs.
15. Patching rusted metal will only be allowed to support: battery, gas tank, transmission cooler, and drivers compartment. No other patching will be permitted anywhere else on the car.
16. No welding on the frame except for the following: leaf spring mounting, bumper brackets, and front a arms.
17. Body mounts may be replaced. They must have 3/4 space between the body and frame. Factory locations only, no extra. Maximum of a 3/4 bolt and a 4 inch washer. No washers on the bottom of the frame.
18. Doors, trunk lids, and or tailgate must be fastened shut by wire or welding. Welding not to exceed 3 inches wide x 12 inch long plate per seam. This can be in sections. Window frame can be wired only, no welding in this area. No tucking doors or tailgate. No plating gas tank doors, taillights, ect. Drivers door may be completely welded, and plated for safety.
19. All thread shocks are permitted.
20. Firewall pipe and a pipe behind drivers seat is recommended, not to exceed 6 inches in diameter. You may also connect the 2 pipes to form a cage around the drivers compartment. Gas tank protectors are permitted and can only be attached to the pipe behind the seat.

Safety & Driving:

- 1. Seat belts, approved helmet, and eye protection are required.
- 2. All lights, mirrors, glass, trim, and interior must be removed prior to entering the fairgrounds.
- 3. All cars must have working brakes prior to and during the entire event.
- 4. The use of drugs and or alcohol prior to or during event will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 5. Cars must be numbered on both doors.
- 6. There will be a 2 minute time limit enforced by track officials.
- 7. There will be 1 warning for the following: Hitting drivers door, sandbagging, and double teaming. 2nd will result in disqualification.
- 8. Cars must remain in boundary lines at all times.
- 9. In the event heat winners car cannot be driven, driver may use any previous heat car for the feature, pending inspection.
- 10. All cars must be removed from fairgrounds within 12 hours. After that cars will become property of track promoter.
- 11. We reserve the right to impose additional rules at anytime.
- 12. Any driver refusing to allow inspection of their car at anytime will be disqualified, and lose any prize money.

Driver Entry:

- 1. Every driver is required to fill out entry form and sign a release.
- 2. Entry fee will be 25.00 with an additional 5.00 if not paid 72 hours before the derby.
- 3. Driver must be at least 16 years of age with valid drivers license, drivers under 18 must have a valid drivers license, and a notarized release signed by parent or legal guardian.
- 4. Officials may inspect car at anytime during the event. Including feature winners.
- 5. All drivers are required to sign a release and waiver of liability indemnity agreement the day of the event.
- 6. The track promoter reserves the right to accept or reject any entry for any reason.
